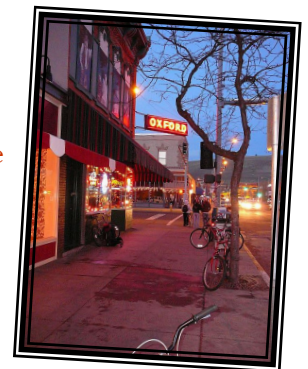


Horseback Riding
